2016 Winemaker Series Sauvignon Blanc paired with a Pesto Mousse Tartlet. Combining the pesto with preserved lemons in this light bite, the acidity in both the food and the wine melds and mellows, allowing the more tropical, bright aspects of this Sauvignon Blanc to flourish.

2015 Winemaker Series Heritage Chardonnay paired with Roasted Corn Croquette. The preserve in this dish enhances the richness of the wine and highlights the crisp apple qualities of the Heritage Chardonnay, while the spices in the chutney compliment the baking and barrel spices in this delicious wine.
